04 Aug 18: Depart Australia

Depart on your overnight flight to Johannesburg.

05 Aug 18: Johannesburg

Upon arrival you will be met and assisted to your shuttle transfer to the hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure before meeting for a briefing with your fellow travellers. Accommodation: Protea Hotel OR Tambo or similar

06 Aug 18: Hazyview (B)

This morning we leave for Mpumalanga, dropping several hundred feet into the lush subtropical region of the Lowveld. 13 Aug 18: Eastern Cape Coast (BD)

Accommodation: Garden Court Mossel Bay or similar

17 Aug 18: Cape Town (B)
